

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Important update

It has been announced by the UK/Scottish Government that as of 16 March anyone developing symptoms consistent with COVID-19, however mild, should stay at home for 7 days from the onset of symptoms as per existing advice. In addition, it is now recommended that anyone living in the same household as a symptomatic person should self-isolate for 14 days after the first household member first gets symptoms.

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature

Information for the public on COVID-19, including stay at home advice for people who are self-isolating, can be found on <u>NHS Inform</u>.

Further, people are advised to take social distancing measures to help reduce the transmission of COVID-19. In particular, this is strongly advised for people aged 70 or over,

people with underlying medical conditions and pregnant women. Further advice on these measures will be available on NHS Inform shortly.

Important note: HPS is updating its guidance in line with this change.

Background

In late December 2019, the People's Republic of China reported an outbreak of pneumonia due to unknown cause in Wuhan City, Hubei Province.

In early January 2020, the cause of the outbreak was identified as a new coronavirus. While early cases were likely infected by an animal source in a 'wet market' in Wuhan, ongoing human-tohuman transmission is now occurring.

There are a number of coronaviruses that are transmitted from human-to-human which are not of public health concern. However COVID-19 can cause respiratory illness of varying severity. Currently, there is no vaccine and no specific treatment for infection with the virus.

On the 30 January 2020 the World Health Organization <u>declared</u> <u>that the outbreak constitutes a Public Health Emergency of</u> <u>International Concern</u>.
